# FROM MARITAL COIUNSELING AND WEDDINGS

You never know who you are marrying. That makes commitment most important in a marriage. Romantic feelings easily fade, or come and go. Aging, illness, tragedies and also success change people. You will likely soon be married to a different person.

And, it is always two sinners who marry. If there is no forgiveness, there is no future. A Christ-centered marriage is one of lived forgiveness. We love as we are loved and forgive as we have been forgiven. Nothing could be more important.

#### FROM A SEMINARY CLASS AND LONG EXPERIENCE

"If someone comes into your office and uses heated words and unfair accusations to attack you, do not react in kind. Instead pretend the person is constipated-- in need of some non-reactive understanding and care." The source of the anger is most often something unrelated to the attack.

Never say "I quit!" in a bad meeting. If it is really bad, take time to write a letter of resignation. Then put it away to read in a day or two in private. Then tear it up and throw it away.

#### FROM HAVING CHILDREN

Each one is different. Be suspicious of programs that give cookie-cutter advice on parenting. "The greatest of these is love."

About education: The more I have learned, the more I have realized how vast are those things I don't know, or fully understand. Know-it-alls are not to be taken

seriously. A little knowledge when mixed with arrogance can be a very dangerous and destructive thing.

#### FROM GROWING OLDER

Being around children and young people rubs off, helping to keep a person young.

Retirement is not for everyone. Many retire too early, quickly to disintegrate mentally and physically.

#### ABOUT RELATING TO OTHERS



#### CHRISTIAN KIDS IN KENYA!

Last year's Vacation Bible School students saw videos on the lives of the children, living in Africa. We learned through the LCMS that there is a project in Kenya called Project 24 and we sent our VBS donation to them. As a result of the excitement our own children had, a parent was motivated to sponsor a boy to go to the Lutheran boarding school in Rongo, located in rural southwest Kenya. The sponsorship was done in the name of Immanuel. The sponsored boy's name is Douglas Mogeni. During this past year Douglas has written letters of appreciation to his sponsor.

There are eight such boarding schools administered by the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Kenya, a partner church with our own Missouri Synod. The schools are built for 80 children. Among the children are many orphans. At Rongo, 25 boys and girls are sponsored at this time. The students attend both school and church throughout the vear. Included on the site is a small farm with two dairy cows which help to sustain the project.

Due to matching funds, current cost for sponsoring a child is \$45 a month. Our VBS donation will again be sent to Project 24.
